Cyber Crime: This is the new Jamtara, the hub of cyber fraud...90 accused arrested, 50 phones, 82 fake SIM cards seized



Nuh . Jamtara is quite famous for cyber fraud in Jharkhand. But now Nuh of Haryana has become the new Jamtara. Cases of cyber fraud have increased tremendously here. This area has now become a stronghold of cyber fraudsters. Police arrested a total of 90 people including 38 cyber fraudsters in two days.

Additional SP Nuh Sonakshi Singh said that a special campaign was launched on Saturday and Sunday. Under this, District Nuh Police Cyber Crimes About 90 accused involved in various criminal cases including 39 thugs were arrested. 50 mobile phones, 82 fake SIM cards, Rs 18180, a stolen motorcycle and other items were recovered from the possession of these accused. Under the special campaign, all the crime investigation branch/staff, Cyber Cell-Teams were formed at

police station and outpost level. In this, police officers and employees raided various places. Meanwhile, the district-Nuh Police Various teams of the police arrested 14 POs and bail jumpers, 07 accused playing gambling and seized Rs 18108 from their possession. 02 thieves were arrested and a motorcycle was recovered. Similarly, 25 accused involved in various other criminal cases were arrested.

Sonakshi Singh Additional SP Nuh said that District Nuh Police attacked cyber criminals with the help of Pratibimb App and arrested 39 cyber thugs involved in cyber fraud. 48 mobile phones, 82 fake SIM cards and other items were recovered from their possession. Apart from this, motor vehicle act Taking action under the Act, a total of 982 people were challaned, including 419 drivers who were driving by changing lanes incorrectly.
